- 1. (6:13-6:22 Discussion time) Follow up from last month's meeting:
  - a. VGS Sign in Vista Village Voted YES to doing this. Did we find a new banner supplier, discussed the \$317 fee to Vista for sign going up plus \$500ish for the banner itself. Has anyone been in contact with the City of Vista or a new banner company? If not, who will this be assigned to? Want it displayed in November & December Need to get an order in to put the sign up *Korina sent in an application that is waiting for approval*
  - b. October 11<sup>th</sup> (this Saturday) possibly have a pop up tent for the event at the Adobe next to Guajome school? Did this get further looked into and are we participating? *Missed deadline, not participating*

- c. Split System likely won't be happening city guys trying to figure out if we can get a unit, waiting on boss to give approval, maybe in Jan/Dec when the bathrooms get redone should be completed before season starts in February
- d. We got a new fridge in the Snack Bar (thank you, Matt!)
